CALL FOR PROPOSALS

DEADLINE: 30 April 2021

As a means to recognize and reward excellence in cinema, audiovisual and/or media pedagogy within the organization, since 2014 the CILECT Executive Council selects up to three (3) Teaching Award recipients each year from qualified nominations:

Nominations

Nominator Eligibility: Only FULL MEMBER schools in good standing may nominate Teaching Award candidates

Re-nomination: Candidates may be nominated up to a total of three (3) separate years OR until they are selected as a Teaching Award recipient. No Teaching Award recipient may be re-nominated.

Nomination Deadline: The nominating school must submit all required materials online to executive.director@cilect.org no later than **30 April 2021**.

Nomination Portfolio: All the following materials must be included in the submitted portfolio:

- 1 Checklist of all items provided
- 2 An official nomination statement from the school written in English and signed by the Head of School or equivalent
- 3 A Teaching Philosophy statement (max 500 words) from the nominee written in English that summarizes the most impactful and/or innovative aspects of their pedagogical approach
- 4 A summary written in English of the nominee's teaching positions related to film, TV and/or media pedagogy with brief (max 50 words each) descriptions of the major courses taught
- 5 A summary written in English of the nominee's most influential publications and/or technological aids related to film, TV and/or media pedagogy. (The list should be supported by copies of the original cover

- 6 A list written in English of the nominee's presentations at national and/or international events (workshops, seminars, conferences, etc.) in the field of film, TV and/or media pedagogy
- 7 A list written in English of the nominee's professional and educational recognitions (awards, grants, etc.)
- 8 A list written in English of the nominee's policy making and/or organizational services in the area of film, TV and/or media pedagogy at national and/or international level
- 9 An audiovisual file up to 10 minutes in length and subtitled in English that shows an excerpt of the nominee's teaching or a relevant presentation of their educational work at the national or international level.

The Executive Director will notify all Full Members and the nominees of the Executive Council's final decision not later than **15 July 2021**.

The winners will be presented and awarded at the **CILECT Congress 2021 in Kristiania University, Oslo, Norway**. NB: All winners' economy class air travel and full accommodation expenses will be covered by CILECT.
